DAY 1

- Pray for adoption of right policies: climate change, gender inequality, mental health, social injustice, data & cyber security.



DECLARATIONS

(Isaiah 65:24, Job 22:27-30, Psalms 65:2, Proverbs 3:1-4,)

- Declare that all the prayers that you have raised to God during this season have been answered.
- Declare possession of your new territory this year by faith.
- Declare that God's will and favour will prevail in your life, family, church, nation and globally.
- Declare economic stability, timely rains and bounty agricultural harvest.

(Psalms 136, Psalm 100)

- Thank God and celebrate his steadfast love and faithfulness as we begin the new year.
